USE THE FOLOWING TIPS TO RID YOUR COMMUNITY OF MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Clean rain gutters weekly to allow water to drain *Remove old tires (dispose of properly) or drill holes used as tire swings *Store wading pools inside or turn upside down * Dispose of all empty beverage containers ,plastic wrap, discarded toys etc. *Check for trapped water in tarps used to cover boats, pools,grills etc. *Pump out bilges in boats. Turn canoes & small boats upside down for storage or remove drain plug. *Replace water in bird baths weekly. *Remove pet food & water containers that are not being used *Flush livestock water troughs weekly. *Keep trash & recycling containers closed,placing lids on cans. * Flush water in the bottom of plant holders twice a week. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Turn over or remove flower pots ;flush water in plant holder weekly. *Fix dripping outside water faucets. *Turn wheelbarrows upside down when stored outside. *Check around construction sites or do-it-yourself improvement projects to ensure proper backfilling and grading to prevent drainage issues. *Check ornamental ponds ,tree holes water-holding low areas for mosquito larvae. *Tidal ditches and flowing water DO NOT breed mosquitoes. *Ditches that do not flow and contain stagent water for 7-10 days can produce large numbers of mosquitoes. Report such conditions to your local Mosquito Control Office. (see below) |
